- To associate promoters, stakeholders & end users.

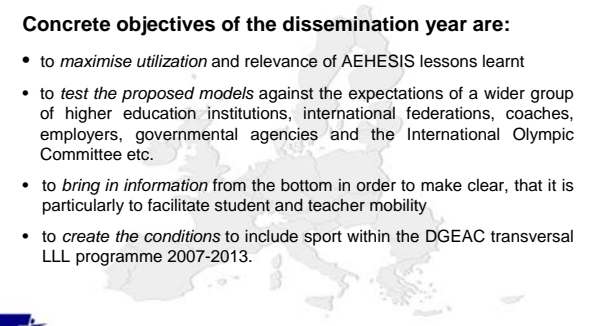

- to *create the conditions* to include sport within the DGEAC transversal LLL programme 2007-2013.

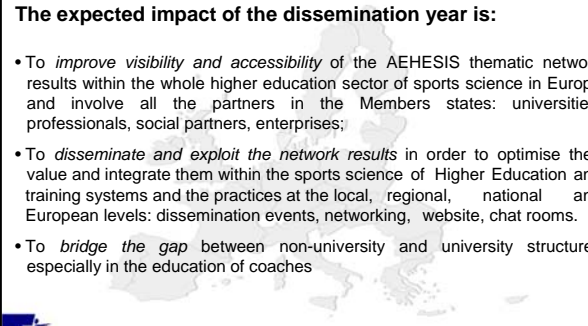

- To *bridge the gap* between non-university and university structures especially in the education of coaches

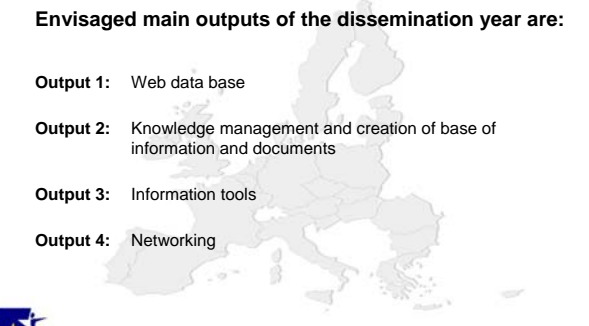

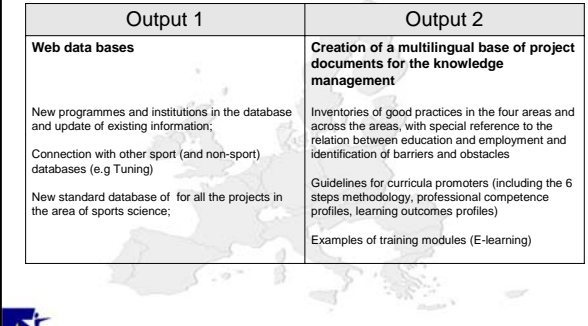
